MetaLib provides you with a quick and easy interface which can metasearch (search simultaneously) for information in a variety of information resources such as fact databases, literature databases and library catalogs.

Once you have found the items you want, MetaLib lets you save them to disc, send them by email and/or use SFX to get to the full-text.

Key features of MetaLib

1. Perform **quick searches** on pre-defined database groupings.
2. Use the MetaLib interface to **find databases** and search them, or to **search across several databases**.
3. Collect interesting references as you go, review them, and save them to disc and/or email them to colleagues.
