

Announcement of a University Professor position at the Max F. Perutz Laboratories - Medical University of Vienna

The Medical University of Vienna (www.meduniwien.ac.at) is one of the largest Academic Medical Schools in the EU area. The **Max F. Perutz Laboratories** (www.mfpl.ac.at) are a joint venture of the Medical University of Vienna and the University of Vienna, focusing on basic research in the biomedical and molecular biology areas. It is located at an attractive, rapidly developing and interdisciplinary biological science campus with an international reputation. In order to strengthen the field of infection biology at the Max F. Perutz Laboratories, the Medical University Vienna announces a full-time and permanent position of a **Professor for Infection Biology**.

Requirements

1. University curriculum with a PhD or MDPHD degree in biosciences,
2. excellent record in basic biomedical research with a focus on infection biology, especially host-pathogen interactions,
3. an outstanding track record in raising competitive third party funds,
4. excellent undergraduate and graduate teaching credentials,
5. skills in leadership – including gender mainstreaming – and scientific management.
6. research experience outside the home country.

The **successful candidate** is expected to:

- Willingness to collaborate with relevant clinical departments at the Medical University.
- Integrate with and strengthen the Medical University research cluster "*Immunology/Allergy/Infection*" and the research area *Infection Biology* at Max F. Perutz Laboratories.
- Strengthen scientific collaborations between clinical departments at the Medical University and the Max F. Perutz Laboratories by establishing internationally peer reviewed research networks or joint doctoral training programs.
- Represent the field in teaching at undergraduate and graduate levels.

The Medical University of Vienna aims to increase the number of women faculty in leading positions, and thus encourages qualified female candidates to apply. In case of comparable qualifications, preference will be given to female applicants.
