Univ.-Prof. Dr. Andreas Bergthaler

is the Head of the Institute for Hygiene and Applied Immunology, a subunit of the Center for Pathophysiology, Infectiology and Immunology (CePII) at the Medical University of Vienna, where he is appointed as well as a full professor for molecular immunology.

Andreas Bergthaler studied veterinary medicine at the Vetmeduni Vienna and performed his doctoral studies with Hans Hengartner and Nobel Laureate Rolf Zinkernagel at the Institute for Experimental Immunology at the University of Zurich. Stays abroad took him to the Royal Dick School of Veterinary Studies, Edinburgh, (UK) and to the Department of Immunology, University of Tokyo (Japan). As a postdoctoral fellow he worked at the University of Geneva (CH) and at the Institute for Systems Biology in Seattle (US). He habilitated in the field of virology at MedUni Vienna.

From 2011, he led a research group at the CeMM Research Center for Molecular Medicine of the Austrian Academy of Sciences in Vienna.
