Manuela Schmidinger is Professor of Medicine and specialises in Internal Medicine, Medical Oncology and Intensive Care Medicine. She is currently a Senior Physician in the Department of Urology, and the Programme Director for RCC at the Medical University of Vienna, Vienna, Austria, leading the research programme in the field of kidney cancer and the care of patients with RCC.

Her research interests include prognostic factors and treatment in RCC, checkpoint inhibitors, tyrosine kinase inhibitor-related side effects, and strategies to achieve long-term survival in metastatic RCC. Professor Schmidinger is the author or co-author of more than 100 articles in peer-reviewed journals, including *Annals of Oncology*, *British Journal of Cancer*, *Journal of Clinical Oncology*, *Leukaemia & Lymphoma* and *New England Journal of Medicine*. She is also co-author of the *European Guidelines for Kidney Cancer Treatment* and the author or co-author of four books in the field of immunology and oncology, including a recent textbook on targeted agents in kidney cancer.
