Professor Pierre Karakiewicz has graduated in Medicine from McGill University in Montreal, where he also completed his residency training in Urology. He then spent three years at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center, where he completed a fellowship in Urologic Oncology, in addition to Public Health Masters Program at Columbia University. Since 2002 he is a Faculty member at the rank of tenured Full Professor at the University of Montreal, where he practices urologic oncology and leads the Cancer Prognostics and Health Outcomes Unit. In addition to Masters and PhD students, he also trains European urology residents in the fields of applied biostatistics and cancer epidemiology with focus on urologic applications. His publications, in excess of 800, focus on prostate, bladder, renal, testicular and penile cancers and his contributions to urology have earned him the EAU 2019 Platinum Award.
