Designed to inspire, encourage and support young people to join the startup scene, Avenue connects students with renowned founders, investors and mentors. In the course of five LABs and a final conference day, participants will gain valuable insight into the world of entrepreneurship.

During the LABs, students from various disciplines are empowered to find ideas and co-founders, turn ideas into business models, and receive first-hand coaching from experienced founders and mentors.

The final highlight of Entrepreneurship Avenue is the Conference. It features a mix of elements, including inspiring keynotes, panel discussions, interactive workshops, specialized breakout sessions, as well as a Startup Fair and a Job Chat.

The LAB-Series kicks off on March 30 at WU Vienna, with four more sessions at other universities in Vienna until the Conference, which takes place on May 12 at WU.

The Entrepreneurship Avenue LAB-Series is for students who are interested in learning how to create, develop and pitch a business idea. It connects students from various universities and disciplines.

LAB #1 is the first event of the Entrepreneurship Avenue. The evening consists of basic keynotes about entrepreneurship, panel discussions with startup-founders and get-to-know games. After the official part there is time for networking.

In LAB #2 participants get the chance to pitch their business idea in order to find a team. After the pitches there is plenty of time to get further information, so that all participants can find their favorite idea and team. From LAB #2 on teams work on their ideas.

About 50 startup experts help the teams make their business model perfect. In LAB #3 the teams meet these mentors for the first time. The teams pitch their already developed business ideas and receive feedback from the mentors

As it gets closer to the Conference Pitch Contest, in LAB #4 the participants learn how to do the perfect pitch. After a keynote from a pitch and presentation expert, the teams will go to separate rooms with pitch-mentors to train their presentations.

In LAB #5 the pre-selection of the teams, which are allowed to take part at the Conference's Pitch Contest, takes place. All Teams pitch in front of a jury that decides who of them is going to have a chance to win great prices at the Conference.
