- All abstracts must be submitted online via the online Submission System as PDF with a maximum size of 10 MB.
- Your abstract must be related to one subject area (as listed below).
- Size limit: max. 250 words (excluding spaces), you may include up to one supporting figure or table. You can use the abstract template provided on the MIC Festival 2022 website, but please strictly follow the scheme for the sections: Objective, Methods and Materials, Results, Conclusion, Funding Sources (not part of word count), References (not part of word count).
- Submissions as PRESENTING AUTHOR are limited to TWO (there is no limitation for co-authorship!)
- The presentation type for the late-breaking abstracts will be as **e-posters**.
- Notifications on acceptance will be sent out end of April 2022
