Language of instruction is English; the school follows the US Pre-K and K–12 educational program; founded 1959, approx. 760 students from over 50 nations; approx. 30% of students are US citizens, age-groups and academic divisions include Elementary School (pre-Kindergarten age 4 years, Kindergarten age 5–6 years, Grades 1 to 5 with ages 6 to 11), Middle School (Grades 6 to 8, ages 11 to 14 years), and High School (Grades 9 to 12, ages 14 to 19 years); students can graduate with an American High School Diploma and additionally the internationally-recognized IB (International Baccalaureate) Diploma and / or the Austrian “Matura Equivalency” program; school fees approx. € 10.156 – 18.600.- per year and per student + € 4.800.- capital assessment and enrollment fee per student / application fee € 165.

Language of education: English. AMADEUS International School Vienna (K-12) was founded in 2012. Unique about AMADEUS is that its academic education is combined with training in classical music. It is also the first international school in Vienna offering on-campus boarding. The academic programme is based on the International Baccalaureate (IB) curriculum for primary and secondary schools, with graduates finishing with the internationally recognized IB Diploma. Augmenting this is the comprehensive music education provided by the AMADEUS Music Academy, which is housed under the same roof. Participation in the music programme is mandatory, but primary students can enter without prior music education. Secondary students should have studied an instrument for at least two years. School fees: from approx. €12,700 to €23,200 / enrolment fee: €3000.

BILINGUAL, CITY-OWNED SCHOOLS

Additional to the above-listed private schools, 7 city-owned primary and 8 secondary- or High-schools work together in the „Vienna Bilingual Schooling“-project. These schools teach according to the national Austrian curriculum, but by using a specially developed bi-lingual teaching-system with both German and English native-speaking teachers.
