### 3./5. Year @ MedUni Vienna: Learning Mobilities

The application for exchange students is an **ONLINE-Application** and no other application will be accepted .

**Deadlines:**

01.- 30. April: application period for the winter term (= October - February)  
01.- 30. Nov.: application period for the summer term (= last week of February - September)

### 6. Year @ MedUni Vienna: Training Mobilities

**Step 1:**

The official Learning Agreement for Traineeships & our Traineeship Acceptance Form have to be sent directly to the respective department for acceptance.

**Step 2:**

After approval by the department the Learning Agreement for Traineeships & the Traineeship Acceptance Form have to be forwarded to the **International Office** of MUV for confirmation by our Institutional Mobility coordinator and for the obligatory registration and enrolment at the MUV.

**Deadlines:**

Registration period for Trainings in winter term (= October - February) : Mid August - 15. November  
Registration period for Trainings in summer term (= March- September) : Mid January - 15. April  
No admission possible from December to mid January & May to mid August!!!

### Written exams for the curricular courses of the year 3/5:

Students who come for the whole academic year have to take the exams at the end of the academic year (end of June/beginning of July).

For students who just come for the winter semester there will be an exam for the courses of term 5/9 in the semester holidays at the end of February.

### Year 5 of the curriculum:

All modules are held three times per semester; therefore it is possible to pick any three courses for either the winter or the summer semester.

### Additional ECTS credits

The students are welcome to add optional subjects according to interest and timetable of the main subjects as soon as they are in Vienna in order to increase the number of ECTS on a voluntary basis.

If required it is in exceptional cases possible to combine curricular courses with clinical clerkships in departments which are not covered within the offered courses such as Internal Medicine or Surgery with a minimum duration of 4 weeks (1,5 ECTS credits per week). Please note that clinical clerkships include no exam and therefore students do not receive a grade. If you need an evaluation, please bring your own evaluation papers.
