The **prerequisites** for a 2- to 12-month stay at Medical University (MedUni) Vienna in the framework of the Erasmus+ SMS Program / SEMP (student mobility for studies) are:

- The applicant needs to be enrolled at a university in the EU/EEA area (Iceland, Norway, Liechtenstein), Turkey or Macedonia for the duration of their stay at MedUni Vienna.
- A **bilateral cooperation agreement** between the applicant's home university and Medical University of Vienna is in place.
- The applicant has **officially been nominated** by the International Office at their home university during the nomination period.
- The applicant can provide proof of **German language proficiency** during the application process (at least CEFR level B1; all curricular courses and exams at MedUni Vienna are held in German)

Application process

Step 1: Nomination by home institution

Nomination period (for coordinators at partner universities): April 1st to April 15th, 2022

IMPORTANT: This deadline applies both to stays starting in fall 2022 and spring 2023 (no separate deadline for stays in the 2023 spring term)!

The International Office will inform Erasmus+ partner universities regarding the nomination procedure in due course via email.

Step 2: Application by student

Application period (for applicants): April 1st to April 30th, 2022

Only applications submitted via the MedUni Vienna application tool "Mobility-Online" can be accepted.

Applicants will receive their login details for Mobility Online upon successful nomination by their home university.

^{*} Only once the course program indicated in Mobility Online has been approved by the MUW International Office, the actual "Learning Agreement" can be created accordingly (see page 8). The Learning Agreement will only be signed on the side of MedUni Vienna if all application steps indicated above have been completed correctly and in due course.



Step 3: Enrolment at MedUni Vienna

Students whose Learning Agreement has been accepted will be enrolled at MedUni Vienna for the duration of their stay (winter term 2022/23, academic year 2022/23 or summer term 2023). In order to complete their enrollment, students need to **transfer the Austrian students' union fee** of currently **21,20** € (status 2022/23) at least two weeks before arrival. Students will receive details on this obligatory payment via email in due course.

Course options

Curricular course modules open to incoming exchange students are:

- o Emergency Medicine / Intensive Care
- Neurology
- Paediatrics
- o Psychiatry
- Ophthalmology / Otorhinolaryngology
- Gynaecology / Obstetrics

Details on the contents and structure of these course modules are available in the <u>study guide</u>. In addition to curricular courses, incoming students can take elective courses according to their interest and timetable (for details see chapter below page 6).

Language of instruction

All curricular courses and exams are held **in German**. Exchange students are allowed to use a standard (i.e. non-medical) dictionary during exams.



Course combinations

The table below shows the six possibilities of how the above-mentioned subjects can be combined in the 2022/23 academic year ("combos" = "Züge" in German).

Every applicant will be assigned to one "combo" (for details on how to indicate preferences please see chapter below).

Combining courses of different combos / switching between combos is not possible.

Note that the following subjects cannot be combined within one semester:

- Neurology and Psychiatry
- o Paediatrics and Gynaecology / Obstetrics
- o Emergency Medicine and Ophthalmolgy/ Otorhinolaryngology

The subjects Ophthalmolgy and Otorhinolaryngology are held consecutively within the same course module, students can choose to participate in both or only one of those subjects.

Indication of course preferences

Students who are planning to spend the entire academic year at MedUni Vienna will be assigned to one combo (no indication of preferences required, as all course modules will be covered) by the International Office.

Students planning to spend only one semester at MedUni Vienna can indicate up to 3 preferences regarding the course combination ("combo") which they would like to be assigned to. The MedUni Vienna International Office will try to assign them according to their first preference. If this is not possible, the second (and after, if applicable, the third) preference will be considered.



Note: Applicants should **check with the responsible person / coordinator at their home university** about their requirements and suggestions *before* entering their preferred program in Mobility Online.

Generally, students are expected to attend all course modules of the "combo" they are assigned to.

Only in exceptional cases (if none of the course combinations listed above can be approved by the students' home institution), **one course module per semester** (1 out of 3) can be replaced by a clinical clerkship ("Famulatur" in German; standard duration 4 weeks; in exceptional cases two week clerkships are possible).

For students whom this applies to, the MUW International Office will contact the hospital department(s) to enquire about their capacities.

In order to increase the chances of a successful assignment, students concerned should indicate several departments.

As the decision on whether and when a department can offer clerkship places is entirely up to the department itself, the International Office can't guarantee upfront that places at a specific department will be available.

Note that some departments may require a different level of German language proficiency (details will be provided).

1,5 ECTS credits can be awarded per week of clinical clerkships. However, clinical clerkships don't entail exams and **no grade/mark** will be assigned.

Interdisciplinary case conferences

Incoming students have the option to register for the so-called **Interdisciplinary Case Conferences**, which are held once per week (2,15 ECTS credits per semester, no grade/mark). A description of this seminar series is available <u>HERE</u> (only in German).

Additional clinical clerkships and elective courses

Students are free to apply for additional, self-organized clinical clerkships ("Famulatur", 2 or 4 weeks, 1,5 ECTS credits per week, no grade/mark) outside the teaching period (during teaching breaks or after end of teaching period).

If applicable, they have to contact the <u>university hospital departments</u> and/or <u>teaching hospitals</u> of MedUni Vienna **directly** to enquire about available places (a list of contact persons at MedUni Vienna departments will be shared via "Mobility Online").

Incoming students also have the option to register individually for elective courses according to their interest and timetable. Details on elective course offerings, however, will be published only shortly before the start of the respective semester <u>HERE</u>.

The International Office can't guarantee that places in specific elective courses will be available.

MedUni Vienna doesn't offer **language courses**. Students who would like to take language classes can refer e.g. to the offerings of the University of Vienna language center ("Sprachenzentrum"): https://sprachenzentrum.univie.ac.at/en/.



Written examination for curricular courses (SIP5a)

MedUni Vienna does not require incoming students to take the written exam. However, it is necessary to pass the exam to receive the ECTS credits of the corresponding lecture. Only students who have passed the written exam will obtain a grade/mark for the curricular course. One overall grade will be assigned for the entire course module (i.e. lecture, practical course/seminar and clinical practical course will not be graded separately).

ECTS credits and hours per course part

Most curricular courses of the 5th year contain three course parts:

- a) Lecture,
- b) Practical Course/Seminar,
- c) Clinical Practical Course.

Students cannot register for those three course elements separately, but only for the entire course module.

Passing the written exam (SIP5a) is necessary to receive the ECTS credits of the corresponding lecture:

Learning Agreement

Before submitting the actual Learning Agreement form, students have to enter their course preferences and complete a sample learning agreement in the application tool "Mobility Online" (by April 30th, 2022).

Once a student's entries in Mobility Online have been marked as feasible by the MedUni Vienna International Office, they will later on serve as the basis for the final Learning Agreement.

Applicants / partner universities are invited to send us the Learning Agreement via EWP. If this is not possible due to technical restrictions, PDF documents will be accepted.

The Learning Agreement has to be signed by the student and their home university before it is submitted to the MedUni Vienna International Office.

Only Learning Agreements signed by all three parties are considered valid.
