Information for Incoming Students

Summer Term 2022

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Preliminary note

The **prerequisites** for a 3- to 12- month stay at Medical University (MedUni) Vienna in the framework of the Erasmus+ SMS Program /SEMP (student mobility for studies) are:

- The applicant needs to be enrolled at a university in the EU/EEA area (Iceland, Norway, Liechtenstein), Turkey or Macedonia for the duration of their stay at MedUni Vienna.
- A bilateral cooperation agreement between the applicant's home university and Medical University of Vienna is in place.
- The applicant has officially been nominated by the International Office at their home university. Applications of students who were not nominated by their home university cannot be considered.
- Since all curricular courses at MedUni Vienna are held in German, applicants need to submit proof of their German language proficiency (at least level B1) during the application process.

Due to the suspension of exchange programs in the winter term, in 2021/22 only applications for the summer term (one semester) can be submitted.

Application process

Step 1: Nomination by the home institution

The International Office will inform Erasmus+ partner universities regarding the nomination procedure in due course via email.

Nomination period (for coordinators at partner universities):

September 15th to October 1st, 2021

Step 2: Application by student

The application for exchange students is an **online application** via the MedUni Vienna application tool **Mobility-Online**. Applications submitted via different channels cannot be accepted. Applicants will receive their login details upon successful nomination by their home university.

Application period (for applicants): **September 15th to October 15th, 2021.**

Documents which need to be provided during the application process:

- Scan of passport / ID (if applicable, please scan both sides)
- Portrait picture (jpg.)
- Immunization record (details available [here](#))*
- Language certificate (details available [here](#))*
- Learning Agreement** (based on the pre-approved sample Learning Agreement prepared in the application portal “Mobility Online”, see page 7/8), signed / confirmed by the home institution and the student;

Note: Only the sample agreement needs to be completed by October 15th. The actual learning agreement will have to be submitted **at a later point in time** (see page 7).

*For the submission of immunization record and language certificate the following deadline applies: **November 15th, 2021.**

Please note that a student’s application can only finally be accepted, i.e. the Learning Agreement can only be signed and returned by MedUni Vienna if all application documents have been submitted correctly and in due course.

Step 3: Enrolment at MedUni Vienna for 2022 summer term

Accepted students will be enrolled at MedUni Vienna for the duration of their stay (summer term 2022). In order to complete their enrollment, students need to transfer the Austrian students’ union fee of currently 20,70€ (status 2021/22) at least one week before arrival. Details on the payment to be made will be sent out via email in due course.

- Psychiatry
- Ophthalmology / Otorhinolaryngology
- Gynecology / Obstetrics

Course combinations

The following table shows the five possibilities of how those subjects can be combined in the 2022 summer term (“combos”; “combo B” won’t be available due to restricted capacities). Every applicant will be assigned to one “combo” (for details on how to indicate preferences please see below).

Note that the following subjects **cannot be combined in the 2022 summer term**:

- **Neurology and Psychiatry**
- **Pediatrics and Gynecology / Obstetrics**
- **Emergency Medicine / Intensive Care and Ophtalmology / Otorhinolaryngology**
- **Gynecology / Obstetrics and Ophtalmology / Otorhinolaryngology**

Indication of preferences regarding course combinations

Applicants for the 2022 summer term can indicate **up to 3 preferences** regarding the course combination during the application process. The MedUni Vienna International Office will try to assign them according to their first preference.

Substitution of individual course modules by clinical clerkships

Generally, students are **expected to attend all course modules of the “combo”** they are allocated to.

Only in case the given course combination **cannot be approved** by the students’ home institution, **one course module** (1 out of 3) can be replaced by a **clinical clerkship** (“Famulatur”).

A clinical clerkship has a standard duration of either 2 or 4 weeks.

If applicable, the International Office will contact the clinical department(s) to enquire about their capacities. In order to increase the chances of a successful assignment, students are encouraged to indicate several alternative departments. 1,5 ECTS credits can be awarded per week of clinical clerkships. However, for clinical clerkships no grade/mark will be given.

Interdisciplinary case conferences

Incoming students have the option to register for the **Interdisciplinary Case Conferences**, which are held once per week (2,15 ECTS credits per semester, no grade/mark)

Additional clinical clerkships and elective courses

Students are free to apply for **additional, self-organized clinical clerkships** (“Famulatur”, 2 or 4 weeks, 1,5 ECTS credits per week, no grade/mark) **outside the semester period** (Easter break or July/August 2022). If applicable, they need to contact the [university hospital departments](#) and/or [teaching hospitals](#) of MedUni Vienna **directly** to enquire about available places.

Incoming students have the possibility to register individually for **elective courses** according to their interest and timetable. Details on elective course offerings will be published only shortly before the start of the academic year.

MedUni Vienna doesn't offer **language courses**, but students who would like to take language classes can refer e.g. to the offerings of the University of Vienna language center (“Sprachenzentrum”):

Written examination for the curricular courses of the 5th year (SIP5a)

MedUni Vienna does not require incoming students to take the written exam.

However, it is **necessary to pass the exam to receive the ECTS credits of the corresponding lecture**.

Only students who have passed the written exam will obtain a grade/mark for the curricular course.

Incoming students staying in the **2022 summer semester** can register for the written exam SIP5a for the attended courses at the end of the academic year (it will be held at the end of June 2022).

Curricular courses of the 5th year: ECTS credits and hours per course part

Most curricular courses of the 5th year contain three **course parts**:

a) Lecture, b) practical course/seminar, and c) clinical practical course.

Students cannot register for those three course elements separately, but only for **the entire curricular course**.

Passing the written exam is necessary to receive the ECTS credits of the corresponding lecture (see table below).

Language of instruction

All curricular courses and exams are held **in German only**. Exchange students are allowed to use a standard (i.e. non-medical) dictionary during exams.

Learning Agreement

Before submitting the actual Learning Agreement form, students have to enter their course preferences and complete a sample learning agreement in the application tool "Mobility Online".

➔ Deadline for completion of this sample learning agreement in Mobility Online: **October 15th**.

In this context, **details of each course and/or clinical clerkship** of the planned semester program have to be indicated, both for the actual course at MedUni Vienna and for the equivalent course at the student's home institution.


Once the student's entries in Mobility Online have been marked as feasible by the MedUni Vienna International Office, they will later on serve as the basis for the actual learning agreement form which needs to be signed by the student, their home institution and MedUni Vienna in order to be valid.

Please note: The actual learning agreement should only be completed and submitted once the MedUni Vienna International Office has accepted a student's application in "Mobility Online".

During the transitional year 2021/22 partner universities are invited to send us their LAs already via EWP, if this is not possible due to technical restrictions also PDF documents will be accepted.

Preparation of sample agreement in "Mobility Online"

Applicants will be asked to enter the selected course at the host institution (Medical University of Vienna) with the required fields **Course unit code**, **Course unit title**, and **Number of credits** (see e.g. ECTS credit table above). The magnifier glass symbol next to the text field opens a drop down menu:



The same three fields (Course unit code, Course unit title, and Number of credits) have to be entered for the corresponding **course at the home institution** which shall be recognized (upon successful completion of the course at MedUni Vienna).

Students have to **refer to their home university's International Office** for details on how the courses can be recognized by the home institution.

As host institution, MedUni Vienna is not involved in the recognition procedures of the home institution.

When entering the details of each course and/or clinical clerkship of the planned semester programme at MedUni Vienna, students have to make sure to stick to the guidelines and information provided in this document.
