

Announcement of a Professorship Position "Bionic Reconstruction" at the Medical University of Vienna

The Medical University of Vienna (MedUni Vienna) with more than 5.500 employees and about 8.000 students is one of the largest academic medical schools in the EU area. At the **Department of Surgery** a **Professorship Position for Bionic Reconstruction** according to § 99 (1) University Act (UG) 2002 is available, starting October 1st, 2020. The appointment is made in accordance with the Salaried Employees Act under a fixed-term contract for a period of three years.

Employment requirements:

- 1. Graduation in humane medicine with a subject specific doctorate or a corresponding foreign university degree in the relevant field of specialization;
- 2. Qualification as a specialist for Surgery, Plastic Surgery, Orthopedics and Traumatology or equivalent domestic and foreign authority;
- 3. Outstanding clinical and scientific qualification in the field of biotechnological interfaces;
- 4. Evidence of the successful acquisition of competitive third-party funds;
- 5. Several years of successful leadership of a scientific working group, leadership and management experience, including competence in gender and diversity issues;
- 6. Experience in interdisciplinary cooperation in clinic and science;
- 7. Educational and didactic qualification;
- 8. International experience.

Applicants are expected to have competence in interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary collaboration within the research cluster and center described in the University's Development Plan, active participation in teaching, commitment to result orientation and the obligation to develop personal management skills.

The MedUni Vienna aims to increase the proportion of women in executive positions and therefore expressly invites qualified female candidates to apply. In case of equivalent qualifications, preference will be given to female applicants.

Applications must be submitted in English to the Rector of the Medical University of Vienna, (faculty-recruiting@meduniwien.ac.at) by June 30th, 2020 at the latest. Applications should include (i) curriculum vitae, (ii) list of publications, (iii) summary of research and teaching activities, (iv) presentation of experiences in the area of organization, management, leadership tasks and performance planning, (v) the ten best publications according to the opinion of the applicant (original scientific papers or reviews appropriate to this announcement) with the possibility of electronic downloading.
