

**Announcement of a Professorship for "Clinical-Experimental Immunology"  
at the Medical University of Vienna**

The Medical University of Vienna (MedUni Vienna) is one of the largest medical universities in the EU with more than 5,500 employees and around 8,000 students. At the Center for Pathophysiology, Infectiology and Immunology a **professorship for "Clinical-Experimental Immunology"** is available from October 1st, 2020. We offer an open-ended employment contract according to the Salaried Employees Act.

Employment requirements:

- Doctoral degree in human medicine or a corresponding foreign university degree in the relevant field of specialization
- Authorization to independently practice the medical profession as a specialist in immunology or clinical immunology or equivalent foreign authorization
- Proof of successful, continuous acquisition of competitive third-party funding
- Outstanding scientific achievements in clinically relevant sub-areas of immunology (such as allergy, transplantation, immune hematology, immunodeficiency, autoimmunity)
- Successful leadership of a scientific working group for several years, leadership and management experience, including competence in gender and diversity issues
- Educational and didactic qualification
- Interdisciplinary cooperation experience
- International experience

Applicants are expected to:

- Inter- and multidisciplinary research to strengthen the research cluster "Immunology/Allergology/Infection & Inflammation" described in the University's Development Plan
- Representation of the specialist area in the integrative and practice-oriented medical curriculum
- Experience in organizing university teaching
- Qualification in employee leadership and motivation
- Commitment to results quality orientation and willingness to further develop personal management skills

The MedUni of Vienna aims to increase the proportion of women in management positions and therefore explicitly requests qualified female candidates to apply. Female applicants will be preferred in case of equivalent qualifications.
