

**Announcement of a Professorship Position for „Bariatric Surgery“  
at the Medical University of Vienna**

The Medical University of Vienna (MedUni Vienna) with more than 5.500 employees and about 8.000 students is one of the largest academic medical schools in the EU area. At the **Department for Surgery** of the MedUni Vienna and the General Hospital of the City of Vienna (AKH) a **Professorship Position for Bariatric Surgery** is available, starting December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. We offer an employment with indefinite duration according to the Salaried Employees Act.

Employment requirements:

1. Graduation in humane medicine with a subject specific doctorate or a corresponding foreign university degree in the relevant field of specialization;
2. Authorization for independent practice as specialist for surgery or equivalent domestic or foreign authority;
3. Profound clinical and scientific qualification in the field of bariatric surgery;
4. Evidence of the successful acquisition of competitive third-party funds;
5. Several years of successful leadership of a scientific working group, leadership and management experience, including competence in gender and diversity issues;
6. Educational and didactic qualification;
7. Experience in interdisciplinary cooperation;
8. International experience.

Expected from the applicant:

- Interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary research in terms of promoting the research cluster described in the University's development plan;
- Representation of the subject area in the medical curriculum aimed at integrative and practice oriented training;
- Competence in employee leadership and motivation;
- Continuation and optimization of the clinical services and procedures in cooperation with other disciplines and clinics as well as the management of the AKH Vienna;
- Commitment to quality outcome orientation and willingness to further enhance the personal management qualifications.

The MedUni Vienna aims to increase the proportion of women in executive positions and therefore expressly invites qualified female candidates to apply. In case of equivalent qualifications, preference will be given to female applicants. Applications must be submitted in English to the Rector of the Medical University of Vienna, ([faculty-recruiting@meduniwien.ac.at](mailto:faculty-recruiting@meduniwien.ac.at)) by October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 at the latest. Applications should include (i) curriculum vitae, (ii) list of publications, (iii) summary of research and teaching activities, (iv) presentation of experiences in the area of organization, management, leadership tasks and performance planning, (v) the ten best publications according to the opinion of the applicant (original scientific papers or reviews appropriate to this announcement) with the possibility of electronic downloading.
