

Announcement of a Professorship Position for Urologic Pathology at the Medical University of Vienna

The Medical University of Vienna (MedUni Vienna) with more than 5.500 employees and about 8.000 students is one of the largest academic medical schools in the EU area. At the **Department of Pathology** a **Professorship Position for Urologic Pathology** according to §98 university act (UG) is available, starting October 1st, 2022. We offer an **employment with indefinite duration according to the Salaried Employees Act.** The Department of Pathology is responsible for the diagnosis of cell and tissue samples of the General Hospital Vienna's patients and provides a supra-regional service as a central diagnostic institution.

Employment requirements:

- 1. Graduation in medicine with a subject specific doctorate or an equivalent foreign university degree
- 2. Qualification as a specialist for pathology or equivalent domestic and foreign authority
- 3. Profound scientific and clinical qualification in the field of urologic pathology
- 4. Successful and continuous acquisition of competitive third-party funds
- 5. Leadership and management experience, including gender and diversity competence
- 6. Experience in interdisciplinary cooperation in clinic and research
- 7. Educational and didactic qualification (evaluation results regarding teaching activities)
- 8. International experience

Expected from the applicant:

- Interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary research in terms of promoting the research clusters described in the University's development plan and the Comprehensive Cancer Center (CCC)
- Representation of the subject area in the medical curriculum aimed at integrative and practice oriented training
- Competence in employee leadership and motivation
- Continuation and optimization of the clinical services and procedures in cooperation with other disciplines and clinics as well as the management of the AKH Vienna
- Commitment to quality outcome orientation and willingness to further enhance the personal management qualifications

The MedUni Vienna aims to increase the proportion of women in executive positions and therefore expressly invites qualified female candidates to apply. In case of equivalent qualifications, preference will be given to female applicants.
