

## Announcement of a Professorship Position for Gynecology at the Medical University of Vienna

The Medical University of Vienna (MedUni Vienna) with more than 5.500 employees and about 8.000 students is one of the largest academic medical schools in the EU area. At the **Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology** of the MedUni Vienna and the General Hospital of the City of Vienna (AKH) a **Professorship Position for Gynecology** according to §98 UG is available, starting as soon as possible. We offer an employment with indefinite duration according to the Salaried Employees Act.

The Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology is currently divided into three clinical divisions: (i) Obstetrics and Feto-Maternal Medicine, (ii) General Gynecology and Gynecological Oncology and (iii) Gynecological Endocrinology and Reproductive Medicine. The successful applicant will be head of the Clinical Division of Gynecology.

Employment requirements:

1. Graduation in Medicine with a subject specific doctorate or an equivalent foreign university degree;
2. Qualification as a specialist for gynecology and obstetrics or equivalent foreign authority;
3. Profound clinical and scientific qualification in the field of gynecology;
4. Successful acquisition of competitive third-party funds;
5. Leadership and management experience, including gender and diversity competence, in particular regarding the leadership of a hospital section of the highest care level;
6. Experience in interdisciplinary cooperation in clinic and science;
7. Educational and didactic qualification;
8. International experience.

Expected from the applicant:

- Interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary research in terms of promoting the research clusters described in the University's development plan;
- Participation at the Comprehensive Cancer Center (CCC) in intensive cooperation with the divisions represented within the CCC;
- Representation of the subject area in the medical curriculum aimed at integrative and practice oriented training;
- Competence in employee leadership and motivation;
- Continuation and optimization of the clinical services and procedures in cooperation with other disciplines and clinics as well as the management of the AKH Vienna;
- Commitment to quality outcome orientation and willingness to further enhance the personal management qualifications.

The MedUni Vienna aims to increase the proportion of women in executive positions and therefore expressly invites qualified female candidates to apply. In case of equivalent qualifications, preference will be given to female applicants.
