

Dear Students,

The **Veronika Fialka-Moser Diversity Award** was created by the Medical University of Vienna in order to raise awareness for and promote a conscious examination of diversity, to enhance its visibility, and to give credit for achievements in the field of diversity.

In 2022, the prize of €2,000 will be awarded in each category: “**Diploma/Master Theses**” and “**Initiatives**”. The invitation is directed to projects that deal with diversity in general or with one or more dimensions of diversity, such as sex/gender, age, ethnic group, family background, disabilities, sexual orientation or religion, among others (see the diversity wheel).

Graduates and students who have completed their **diploma/master thesis** no more than two years ago (graded after 01.01.2020), and their supervisors, are cordially invited to submit. Supervisors who are employed at the Medical University of Vienna or have a teaching/supervising assignment are also invited to submit with the student.

For the category “**Initiatives**”, submissions will be accepted from working groups and projects that deal with diversity in an outstanding way and with extraordinary commitment. The initiatives/projects can focus on one or more specific aspects of diversity (for example age, disability, sex/gender, sexual orientation, cultural or social background etc.) or deal with diversity in general.

The deadline for submissions is **31st December 2021**.
