

Depending which grading system is used in your country, you will have different reference points of your lowest and highest score At first you will need to convert your gradings to the American grading system, which only uses a four letter grading system (AB,CD,F). Each letter represents a certain amount of points. A= 4, B=3, >>2, D=1, F=0. Now you have the needed data set to calculate your GPA. You can use the <u>scholaro GPA calculator</u> for it. For Austrian ranking systems, we advise you to use following formula: Build in the round brackets the sum of all your ECTS points including your grade points of your courses and multiply this sum by the number of grade points. Round up the end results by 2 decimal laces. Eg. [(2 ECTS / course with grade point 1) x 4] + [(2 ECTS / course with grade point 2) x 3] + [(2 ECTS / course with grade point 3) x 2]+ [] + [(2 ECTS / course with grade point 4) x 1] + [(2 ECTS / sourse with grade point 5) x 0] divided by 2 ECTS As a reference, the OECD offers a helpful guide, how to relate different international grading system to the GPA (1-4) score system.




