The following courses and number of ECTS points must be achieved:	
6 ECTS - Propedeutika 4 ECTS – Basic Lectures 18 ECTS - Journal Clubs 12 ECTS – Thesis seminar / seminar for doctoral candidates	
Students who have enrolled from WS 2019/2020 onwards must also pass the following compulsory courses:	
10 ECTS – thesis registration/working plan (drafting and defense) 6 ECTS - Presentation PhD Symposium	
The required number of ECTS points must be achieved before the viva at the latest.

Upload your dissertation to MedCampus in PDF/A format only . Your dissertation must not exceed the size of 18 MB. Info on the review process	
If there are no more corrections to be made after the plagiarism check, your dissertation will be sent out to 2 reviewers. However, if the plagiarism check suggests corrections, we will inform you and you will have to upload your dissertation again in MedCampus. Average duration of the plagiarism check: approx. 1 - 2 weeks Average review duration: approx. 2 months	
We will send you received reviews anonymously by @mail.	
Doctoral viva	
After you have submitted two positive reports, we will inform you of three viva committee members nominated by the Curriculum Directorate. You can then arrange the date and location of your viva with the examiners yourself. Once you have successfully completed your viva, your certificate will be issued and you will be notified by us for collection. Please take the registration confirmation from the library (<u>http://repositorium.meduniwien.ac.at/</u>) with you at the latest when you collect your certificates.	
Academic ceremony
